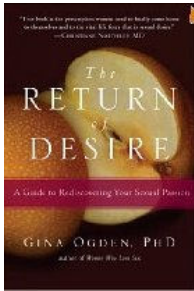
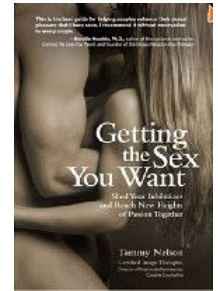


The Return of Desire — Getting the Sex You Want A Teleseminar for Health Professionals
